## **Bus Registration**

You will need to register your child for the bus online by **September 30<sup>th</sup>**. Please follow these steps to do so:

- 1. Go to www.sd58bc.ca.
- 2. Under the "Parents and Students" tab, click "Bus Information".
- 3. Scroll down and click "Princeton Bus Registration".
- 4. Answer the questions as they appear. This should take you less than a couple of minutes. You may sign your child up for more than one bus route if your child resides in more than one home.

This year's bus students will receive a new bus pass shortly. You will have to notify our office if your child needs to be registered for more than one stop.

# Medical

Please contact the school if your child has a <u>new</u> medical condition. Parents of a student with a pre-existing medical condition have been sent an email from our secretary already.

# **Attendance and Messages**

Please use the Safe Arrival system to excuse your child from school, record a late arrival or early departure to school. All excuses should be sent in before 9:00 am for that day. Please call our office if you have questions.

We understand that emergencies happen, and you may need to give a message to your child through the secretary. We ask that if possible, please make the arrangements for your child before coming to school as we have a high volume of messages at the end of each day.

#### Before & After School, Recess and Lunch

Please review the daily school schedule as our recess and lunch times have changed. Please note that your child will eat prior to playing outside during their lunch time opposed to eating after playing like we have done in the past.

VFE is a <u>NUT-AWARE</u> ZONE! PLEASE REMIND YOUR CHILD TO BRING ONLY NUT-FREE FOODS TO SCHOOL.

The staff parking lot and bus drop off zones are <u>not</u> available to the public for the safety of our students. Parents may use the parking lot by the stairs along Ridgewood Drive.

VFE has a limited number of microwaves that are available to students at lunch time. We encourage students to bring a thermos or cold lunch to school to ensure that their eating time is utilized efficiently.

Students are not permitted to use cell phones or electronics during eating at lunch, however they are able to use them responsibly during playtime at lunch.

For safety reasons, all students who do <u>not</u> take the bus are asked to start walking home immediately after school, unless they are waiting for a sibling or walking buddy on a bus that drops off at VFE. Your child is permitted to come back to the school to play provided they check in with a parent or authorized adult and get permission to do so. A reminder that our supervisors are on duty in the morning from 8:00 am to 9:00 am and after school from 3:00 pm to 3:30 pm. We ask that you drop off and pick up your child as close to the bells as possible.

A reminder that students are required by law to wear a bicycle helmet that meets safety standards. Our staff will continue to enforce this law if we see students riding bicycles, skateboards, scooters, etc. without helmets.

## **BC Agriculture in the Classroom Foundation**

Our school participates in the BC School Fruit and Vegetable Program. This program provides free healthy fruit and vegetable snacks to students periodically throughout the school year. The idea of this program is to encourage healthy eating habits. Should you have any questions or do not want your child to participate in this program, then please contact the school. We have excluded all fruits and vegetables that are listed as allergies.

# **Parent Volunteers**
